## Person County Quilt Trail Application (continued)

All quilt blocks and site locations must be approved by the Person County Quilt Trail Committee. Please include a photo of the barn/building and quilt block (or design) with application. In making this application, you agree to accept the following conditions and requirements:

- ✓ The guilt block will be visible from the road.
- ✓ The guilt block must be square in design and not smaller than 4x4 nor larger than 8x8.
- ✓ The quilt block cannot be my company logo, nor used as my company logo.
- ✓ The quilt block must remain on the approved site for at least 5 years. The Quilt Trail Committee must be notified immediately if/when block is removed after this time.
- ✓ The quilt block is my property and its maintenance and long-term upkeep is my responsibility.
- ✓ I understand that having a quilt block as part of the Person County Quilt Trail may increase traffic and/or visitors to site location.
- ✓ I will allow my quilt block to be photographed by the public and photos to be used in advertising and promotional materials by the Person County Quilt Trail.
- ✓ I will allow my name and/or my business name to be used by the Person County Quilt Trail in advertising and promotional materials.
- ✓ I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Person County Quilt Trail as well as its officers, committees, agents and employees for and against any and all claims, liabilities, losses and causes of action related to the guilt block and guilt trail.
