The Board of Commissioners for the County of Person, North Carolina, met in recessed session on Tuesday, December 15, 2020 at 9:00am in the Person County Office Building Auditorium.

Chairman Powell called the recessed meeting to order.

ADOPTION OF 2021 SCHEDULE OF VALUES/PRESENT-USE VALUE SECTION:

Tax Administrator, Russell Jones presented the Schedule of Values/Present-Use Value Section to the Board for adoption. At the Board's December 7, 2020 meeting, the Board voted to table action to this date to allow time for the new commissioners have further discussions with Mr. Jones related to the Schedule of Values and the process getting to the recommended values. Mr. Jones stated he met with Commissioners Gentry and Palmer, and on another occasion with Commissioner Sims to answer questions; he appreciated the opportunity to answer their questions.
