In an emergency, seconds matter!

A correct, clearly visible, and properly placed address will help emergency responders find you.

Check to see if yours is correct!

Is your address:

- *Posted in a visible location?*
- *Reflective?*
- *Covered by vines or bushes?*

Did you know...

Addresses are assigned by an official address coordinator.

There is a law regulating the display of addresses and road signs.

E-911 Address Requirements

*If you call 911, can first responders
find you in time?*

Poor

No Numbers at all.



These numbers are 3/4 inch tall and difficult to see from a distance.



Addresses should not be painted on the curb.



Address numbers must contrast with the background color.



Pretty, but nearly impossible to read.

Better



Large numbers, but still hard to distinguish from a distance.



Pros: Large, easy to distinguish numbers.
Cons: Can only be seen from one direction, not reflective.



Flowers, vines, and grass can quickly overtake your address numbers.

Best



- Large, contrasting numbers
- Reflective
- Seen from both directions
- Clear of vegetation
