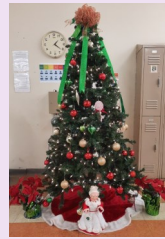

EVERYDAY TIPS TO KEEP YOU HEALTHY



Wash your hands often with soap & water.



Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze and toss in the trash after use.

Try to avoid close contact with sick people.



If you are sick with flu-like illness, stay home for at least 24 hours after your fever is gone without the use of fever-reducing medicine.



Practice good health habits. Get plenty of sleep & exercise, manage your stress, drink plenty of fluids, and eat healthy food.

Winter Health Tips:

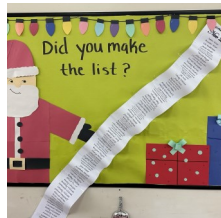
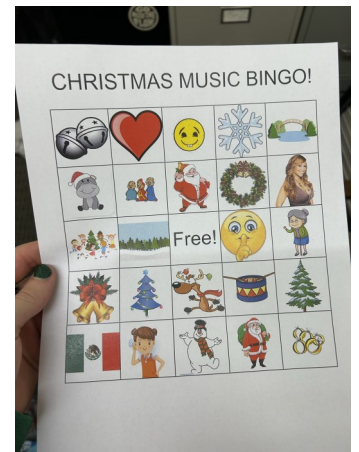


PI Christmas Party—Oh What Fun It Was
