Show Rules:

- 1. Contestants must keep dog on leash and under control.
- 2. All dogs must be in good condition, healthy, and up to date on all of their vaccinations.
- All youth under 8 years old showing dogs must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- 4. All decisions are judges' opinions and ribbons will be awarded to all participants.
- 5. Please be responsible and clean up after your dog.
- 6. Animals may be entered in no more than 2 categories
- 7. NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ACCIDENTS

Show Category Descriptions:

Show Category Descriptions (only choose two categories)

CRAZIEST FOR A TOY: Owner must bring the dog's favorite toy and we'll judge which one goes craziest for their toy.

BEST COSTUME: Looking at whether the costume is cute, funny, and original.

BEST TRICK: It will be judged on trick difficulty, dog responsiveness, timeliness of trick performance and creativity.

CUTEST PUPPY: Aged between 4 months and 1 year. Judged on charm and friendliness.

BEST KISSER: Admit it. You let your dog kiss you. You might as well get a ribbon for it. Dogs not permitted to kiss the judges.

MOST EAR-RISTIBLE EARS: Judges are looking for dogs that have ears that they think are really cute, have character or stand out in some way. They could be extra large, super floppy or have good coloring.

HAIRIEST: Judges are looking for those loveable shaggy and hairy dogs even if we can barely see their eyes.

MOST UNUSUAL COLORS: No matter what kind of mix your breed is, we want to reward it for being colorful and different.

FRIENDLIEST: For the dog that wants to make everyone his new best friend. Dogs to be judged on their ability to coddle up to a perfect stranger. The dog should be enthusiastic with the judge... wagging tail, kisses, jumping on the judge, etc. (separate male and female classes)

SMALLEST (ADULT DOG): We do believe that beauty can come in small packages so this is for dogs less than 40 lbs.

LARGEST: We also know that your dog can be big and still be beautiful so this is for dogs 40lbs and over.

MOST BEAUTIFUL: The judges will decide which dog is the most beautiful and/or handsome. (separate male and female classes)

BEST GROOMED: Dogs to present a neat and clean appearance, Attention is given to teeth, ears, nails and coat condition.

SENIOR DOG: Dogs, 8 years and over, are to be judged on condition, healthy appearance, and a "well cared for look".

BEST TAILWAGGER: Judges are looking for enthusiastic waggers or dogs with a unique wag.

BEST VOCALIST: Dogs to be judged on quality, sweetness, loudness or variety of vocalization.

Entries are limited to only 2 categories per dog
