

## Site Plan Worksheet

<u>All applications must include a site plan</u>. The site plan shows the preferred location of the house, driveway, and any other proposed structures. The proposed location of the septic system and well may also be shown. You will be contacted by an Environmental Health Specialist if the proposed site plan needs to be adjusted to accommodate the well and septic system.

The site plan must include the following information:	
	Dimensions of the property. (Existing or proposed).  Proposed size and location of the house. The exact footprint of the house is not required as long as it fits within the proposed area. Measurements from at least two property lines to the proposed house location must be shown.
	Proposed driveway location.  Proposed location of the septic system and well (optional).
	Location and size of additional structures (Proposed or future additions). This includes sheds, garages, workshops, pools, etc.
	Locations of wells or septic systems on adjacent properties (if known).  Location of easements (access, power lines, or others) on the property (if known).
